Presidio School has the responsibility to post and mail information pertaining to regularly scheduled School Board meetings, Open Houses, advisory committees and various other school functions.
You have the responsibility to ensure that your student attends school on a regular, consistent basis. You have the right to request attendance inquiries on your student. You have the right to timely attention to problems or disputes regarding attendance.	Presidio School has the responsibility to notify parents via postcard when their student has been placed on attendance probation, to respond to attendance inquiries in a timely fashion and if requested, to conference with the student/parents regarding a behavior modification plan designed to remediate attendance problems.
